Financial Update

Maureen and Geraldine provided an update on the CSC financials as follows:

- Current balance is \$1538.91, including grant for parent involvement grant. \$1000 is held in reserve for grade 8 grad.; remaining funds are available to Parent Council.
- Money from FlipGive has accumulated as well \$413.87, a payout has been requested and are in transit. Since inviting participation within the school community, 36 people have joined the SFX team. Of those members, 10 shoppers have raised an additional \$236.38.
