Fundraising ideas:

- McGregor's Meats maybe in the spring in time for BBQ season. (it was successful last time we did it; we raised approx \$2700)
- Flipgive promote it more as a low key fundraiser. We could continue to promote it via school communications, including X and school bulletins.
- Silent auction
- Produce basket a parent knows of a school that held this fundraiser last year, with success. A positive point is that the price point was a bit better compared to the expense of McGregor's.
- Big Box of cards history is that the school tried it once and complaint that parents can buy them at the dollar store cheaper. Return to the school is about \$10 per box.
- Terra Cotta Cookies purchase tubs of cookie dough for about \$10 to \$15.
- Poinsettia sale at a previous school was a success; however, SFX has tried it previously and there was not much interest.
- We need to run 1 major and 2 minor fundraisers over the year this will be verified.
- Pizza night was run in the past with Dominoes and raised about \$350.
- Feedback was mixed with respect to Laura Secord chocolates i.e., the brand was welcomed change but the price point was more.

Round Table Discussion:

Question from parent - is there a way to communicate upcoming extracurriculars to parents so there is awareness? This communication is important for all kids, in particular kids who are unable to communicate the information to their parents. It is an inclusive approach to extracurriculars.

Response from admin - An issue may be that often the information is in real time - i.e., the tryouts are announced over morning announcements without much notice to admin. That said, maybe X

(formerly Twitter) can be used to communicate ad hoc. Google classroom is a tool that could also be used by teachers. School bulletin can include a general idea of what is going on from month to month. Also post it to the bulletin board near the gymnasium so that kids can also read about it.
